


# Qvidium Master Key License System

1. Point your browser to [http://69.5.14.25/license\\_mgmt/](http://69.5.14.25/license_mgmt/). You should see a web page similar to:



2. Enter your Master Key and click on the Get button. You should see a web page similar to:




3. Retrieve your ID from your proxy. Here's how to retrieve the ID for instance 1 from a Linux shell:

```
# tx_proxy -I 1 -C foobar

Product Name = QVARQ Send Proxy
Program is not registered
Identification = BD5E80CB1EAC53D7972A13E162BEEA427B44D125
```

To retrieve the second instance you use "-I 2" on the command line. The "-C" option checks a file to see if it is a valid license file. The above example uses a non-existent file called foobar to cause the proxy to display its Identification.

- Copy the Identification to the System ID field on the web page and click on the Get License button.



- Save the license file to your system and then verify the license is good:

```
# tx_proxy -I 1 -C ~/Downloads/BD5E80CB.lic
License: Permanent
```

- Copy the license file to the appropriate directory.
- Point your browser to [http://69.5.14.25/license\\_mgmt/](http://69.5.14.25/license_mgmt/), enter you Master Key and click on the List button to see licenses issued:
